I am still channeling the "Hieroglyphic Staircase" by Drew Dillinger.

"it's 3:23 in the morning and I'm awake because my great great grandchildren won't let me sleep my great great grandchildren ask me in dreams what did you do while the planet was plundered? ...what did you do while the earth was unraveling? ...what did you do once you knew?"

The question that many of us are asking now is, "What am I supposed to do?" The power of the dragon seems so absolute—the violence so ingrained, the systems of oppressions so pervasive, minds warped by greed and selfishness so set and so wrong—that depression and apathy seem appropriate. We made the dragon; we can unmake it. We can create a new reality, a reality that is not based on separation and objectification. This is the message hidden in our Christian tradition of God's new creation. This is the message in the work that reconnects by Jonna Macy of the great turning (See "Entering the Bardo," below). This is the message from Charles Eisenstein in *The More Beautiful World Our Hearts Know is Possible.* This is the message from Thomas Berry:

"The historical mission of our times is to reinvent the human – at the species level, with critical reflection, within the community of life-systems, in a time-developmental context, by means of story and shared dream experience." (Thomas Berry, "Reinventing the Human," in The Great Work, 159).

And from Drew Dillinger in the short video "The Power of Story" that we watched at our last meeting:

We need to build a movement that connects ecology, social justice, and cosmology (worldview) using the power of dream, the power of story, the power of art, and the power of action.

When I lie awake at 3:30 in the morning, I'm crying for the birds, for the species that have gone and are going extinct. When I wake up, I remember that I am not alone in my searching. My question becomes:

What did we do when we knew?

Speaking of cosmology and a new reality, as we are in Sarbmeet Kanwal's talk referenced below, I am reading *Helgoland: Making Sense of the Quantum Revolution* by Carlo Rovelli (Rivershead Books, 2020). I should say reading and re-reading because even though Rovelli does an excellent job of explaining quantum physics without equations for the layperson, the concepts are still complicated. Take Schrodinger's cat, whom we have all met before. There are several theories that try to rationalize the quantum weirdness of the superposition of the animal who is both alive and dead (Rovelli prefers to say asleep) until observed. These include, for example, "Many Worlds," which proposes that the cat is alive in one world and asleep in another and the number of possible worlds multiplies; "Hidden Variables" a theory by David Bohm, which is brilliant and un-understandable; "Physical Collapse of the Wave Function" which posits different behavior for macro and microscopic entities; QBism.... And then there's Rovelli's proposal that:

"Instead of seeing the physical world as a collection of objects with definite properties, quantum theory invites us to see the physical world as a net of relations. Objects are its nodes." (p. 79)

Suddenly we are in the realm of <u>Indira's net</u>, a metaphor of Mahayana Buddhism that illustrates the interpenetration, inter-causality, and interbeing of all things. And this famous quote by Thomas Berry:

"That the universe is a communion of subjects rather than a collection of objects is the central commitment of the Ecozoic. Existence itself is derived from and sustained by this intimacy of each being with every other being of the universe." (Brian Swimme and Thomas Berry, The Universe Story, 243)

Suddenly, I'm ready to read the second half of the book!

In this op-ed, eco-philosopher and Buddhist scholar Joanna Macy introduces us to the *bardo*—the Tibetan Buddhist concept of a gap between worlds where transition is possible. As the pandemic reveals ongoing collapse and holds a mirror to our collective ills, she writes, we have the opportunity to step into a space of reimagining.

"WE ARE IN a space without a map. With the likelihood of economic collapse and climate catastrophe looming, it feels like we are on shifting ground, where old habits and old scenarios no longer apply. In Tibetan Buddhism, such a space or gap between known worlds is called a bardo. It is frightening. It is also a place of potential transformation."
