We opened the meeting with a period of guided meditation facilitated by Justin Michael on "You are Enough" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Inmyn_W01SI. We considered the queries Why Wars? Why Climate Destruction? Why Ukraine? We watched an interview of William Ury by Thomas Hübl in an episode of the Collective Trauma Online Summit. William Ury, co-founder of Harvard's Program on Negotiation, has over the decades helped war-ravaged societies overcome their collective trauma to reach common goals of peace and prosperity. Thomas Hübl is a spiritual teacher, founder of The Academy of Inner Science, and author of Healing Collective Trauma: A Process for Integrating Our Intergenerational and Cultural Wounds
