Fourth Person: The Knowing of the Field

> It's a piece that came out a few days ago (co-authored with my colleague Eva Pomeroy) that aims at extending the focus of scientific inquiry from the surface to the deeper layers of the systems thinking iceberg (from the outer to the inner, from the parts to the whole). This deepening of our understanding and acting implies to move beyond the traditional modes of knowledge:

1st person knowledge: subjective 2nd person knowledge: intersubjective 3rd person knowledge: objective

to accessing the deeper layers of knowing that inspire and animate all profound processes of regeneration and deep systems transformation on earth:

4th person knowing: the knowing of the field (deepened collective self-knowing and awareness).

If I have learned anything in my past 25 years as an action researcher who tries to help people to advance their initiatives of transformational change, it is this: unless you can access this deeper source of knowing, nothing truly transformational is going to happen with the system you try to change. Whereas the experience of 4th person knowing is quite distributed in our communities (by experiences of letting-go, letting-come and profound regeneration or renewal), it has remained in our institutions of science and education largely a blind spot, which keeps limiting our current efforts of movement building and systems change.
